



Community Market POLICY

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 To bring the school community together in a social setting.
- 1.2 To provide the students, parents and any other interested person with a venue for selling homemade food, goods and services.
- 1.3 To provide the children with opportunities to develop real- life maths and social skills when they decide to have a stall

2. AIMS

- 2.1 Food needs to be home made
- 2.2 No highly processed food to be sold.
- 2.3 Food safety standards need to be met- as per guidelines in *Australia New Zealand Food Standard Code – 3.2.2 - Food Safety Practices and General Requirements – October 2014*
- 2.4 Food servers must wear gloves/use tongs if handling food.

3. SUSTAINABILITY GUIDELINES

We encourage all stallholders to be sustainable by:

- 3.1 Not providing disposable plastic packaging or any single use items unless they are biodegradable (such as plain paper napkins)
- 3.2 Not using disposable plastic cups to sell drinks
- 3.3 Using biodegradable products where possible
- 3.4 Stalls selling drinks need to provide re-useable mugs or cups that can either be borrowed (depending on numbers) from the milkshake stall or brought in and managed by the stall holder

4. IMPLEMENTATION

- 4.1 Market coordinator to ensure all food stall handlers are using tongs to distribute food.
- 4.2 Tables need to be booked by Thursday morning
- 4.3 Tables need to be packed away in the canteen by person holding the stall at the end of the market
- 4.4 10% of the taking need to be donated to the school as goodwill
- 4.5 Stall holders to supply their own 'kitty' of change

EVALUATION

This policy will be reviewed on a 3 year cycle.
