You should always feel safe

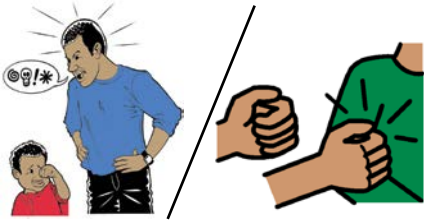
- at school

- hurt you with words or actions



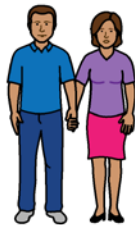
- make you feel scared



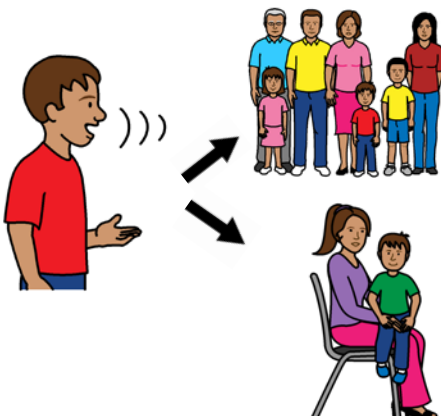
- touch you in places you do **not** want to be touched.

What should I do if I do not feel safe?

Tell an adult you trust, for example



- a parent

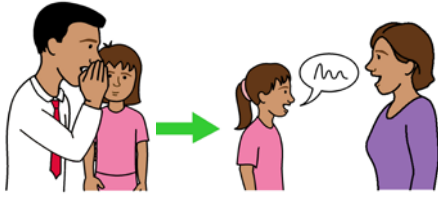


- a family member

- a carer



- a teacher.



Tell an adult even if someone says
do not tell anyone.



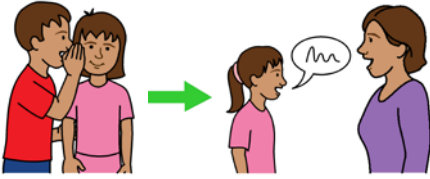
When you tell an adult you will **not** get
in trouble.

If you do **not** feel safe it is **not** your fault.



You do **not** need to fix the problem on
your own.

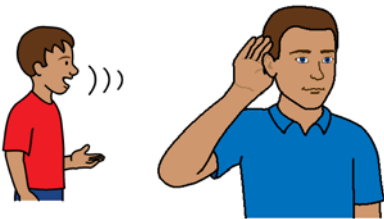
What should I do if I think someone else is not safe?



Tell an adult you trust even if the person says **do not tell anyone**.



It is important to make sure the person is safe.



What will happen when I tell an adult at school?

The adult **must** listen and help.



The adult might need to tell other people to keep everyone safe.



Who else can I tell?
