NAPLAN

Next week, our year 3 and 5 students will be participating in the NAPLAN tests. These are nationwide assessments with parents receiving a report about their child's literacy and numeracy achievements. The schedule is as follows:

Tuesday 11 May – Language conventions (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and Writing Wednesday 12 May – Reading

Thursday 13 May – Maths

It is important to remember that NAPLAN is only one form of assessment and while it demonstrates what the child was able to do on the day, it does not reflect all the student is capable of.

Students at our school are involved in continuous dialogue with teachers reflecting on and analysing their work together. Teachers and students use work samples and a range of classroom based assessments to identify the learning achieved and to set personalised learning goals to guide future learning directions. Learning is a continuous journey and it is vital students are active participants in the process.
